Bodegas Sumarroca Penedès, Spain

Passion for the land, a perfect combination between tradition and innovation! That is how the family Sumarroca describes their philosophy and true to their word, they produce amazing Cava of fabulous quality, character and balance!

CAVA BRUT RESERVA 2013 | Bodegas Sumarroca £23.00

Combining the fruitiness of Chardonnay with the finesse provided by a touch of Parellada. The purity is guaranteed, with no dosage and long ageing over 36 months.

CAVA BRUT ROSÉ | Bodegas Sumarroca £25.00

A bright pink colour with slight beading of persistent bubbles. A very intense cava with elegant notes of red fruit and strawberries combined with floral hints. Fruity and unctuous in the mouth, with a delicate finish.

CAVA BRUT NATURE GRAN RESERVA | Bodegas Sumarroca £30.00

Pale yellow colour. Fresh, complex aroma that mixes pastry notes from the cava's 36-month ageing with light hints of fresh fruit from the base wine. Fresh and smooth on the palate, with very fine bubbles that perfectly complement the wine's complexity. An elegant, serious finish, long and dry, bringing out the essential flavour of the cava.

CAVA PINOT NOIR ROSÉ BRUT | Bodegas Sumarroca, £32.00

Magical encounters! The vines producing the grapes are over 25 years old and have been selected for their elegance and finesse. This comes from the exceptional Pinot Noir vineyards at Moli Coloma.

CAVA ALLIER GRAN BRUT | Bodegas Sumarroca £34.00

Complex aromatic range, softened by long ageing over 36 months in barrels. Made mainly of Chardonnay and finished with an elegant touch of Pinot Noir.

CAVA NURIA CLAVEROL GRAN RESERVA | Bodegas Sumarroca £37.00

This is a very special cava, named after the wife of Charles Sumarroca, the winery's founder. The bottle carries a dedication from her three sons: "Tribute to our mother whose love for the land has lasted all her life". This is 100% Xarelo-lo vines with a distinctive personality.

- UMBRELE CHARDONNAY 2015** | Vilie Timisului, Romania £20.00
Wonderfully fresh and fruity, with amazing power and fruit. Ripe and thick, lots of mango and toasted oak. Chewy buttery and intensely tropical side to this full bodied wine
- BLANCO ORGANIC 2015** | Campo Flores, La Mancha, Spain £20.00
Bright straw yellow, vibrant fresh but intense pear. Peach flavours with citrus fruit and a hint of grapefruit. Quite floral and aromatic.
- NOSTROS RESERVA SAUVIGNON BLANC 2014** | Indómita, Casablanca, Chile £22.00
Bright greenish colour with a steel grey hue. Signature grassy character filled with white flowers, lemon peel and white peach. Restless and intense character with a delicious freshness.

The Zuccardi family and their Santa Rosa Winery was one of the first wineries in Argentina to produce Viognier, and the long experience shows! Well balanced with a crisp acidity. Apricot fruit is dominating on the palate with just a touch of spice.

This classic Burgundian variety has been produced in the sunny climate of the South of France. Great care has been taken to ensure that the wine is as elegant as wine from Côte d'Or. Yellow gold hue and seductive scents of blossom and cinnamon. A melange of pears, peach, honey, toffee, cream and vanilla on the palate, from the short spell of oak ageing. A very classy Chardonnay!

PIERRE ET PAPA ROSÉ 2015 IGP Pays D'Hérault, Languedoc	£21.00
Bright pink, this is a light and refreshing rosé bursting with red fruits, lychee and green apple, a perfect balance of roundness and length which makes for an easy drinking wine for all seasons.	
PINOT GRIGIO BLUSH ROSE 2015 Mabis, IGT Veneto, Italy	£22.00
Typical light copper colour. A fine and elegant nose, well supported by fruity and flowery notes, fresh, mineral and well balanced, with persistent fruity aftertaste.

An intense succulent, juicy red wine which is luscious and rugged. Supple ripe strawberry and blackcurrant fruit provides the character, and a warming spicy finish gives personality to this delicious honest red.	
UMBRELE SYRAH 2015 Ville Timisului, Romania	£20.00
Cherry red colour with a fruit filled nose and smoky nuances. Integrated toasty oak with the great Syrah flavours.	
NOSTROS RESERVA MALBEC 2014 Indómita, Bío Bío Valley, Chile	£22.00
Deep and intense ruby colour, mature and aromatic. A fine and elegant wine with well-balanced levels of alcohol and acidity. Flavours of black cherry, strawberry, and raspberry. On the nose powerful, sweet notes. A lingering finish, flavourful with velvety, soft and ripe tannins.	
CASSE NOIX CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2014 IGP Pays D'Oc, Languedoc, France	£22.00
Garnet red in colour, perfumed with fragrant black cherry, cassis, black pepper and cinnamon. Full bodied and intense with countless layers of flavour including blackcurrant, cedar and graphite. Dense fruit on the palate is bound by a structure of fine grained tannins and a lively acidity. This wine shows great depth and character and yet is refined with a long, elegant finish	
DEALTO CRIANZA 2013 DOCa, Rioja, Spain	£22.00
Aromatic and intense with lovely aromas of wild red berries, blossom, nutmeg and hints of sandalwood. Fresh, fruity and well balanced with sensations of raspberries, vanilla and cinnamon. A wine with great purity and depth of fruit gently caressed by oak but never smothered. Textural, well balanced and a great expression of Rioja.	





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MONTSABLÉ PINOT NOIR 2015 IGP Pays D'Oc, Languedoc, France	£22.00
This classic Burgundian variety has been produced in the sunny climate of Languedoc. Red ruby colour. Aromatic nose of black cherries with elegant floral notes. On the palate, this Pinot Noir is silky and well balanced, with smooth tannins.	
ARMADOR MERLOT 2014 Odfjell, Central Valley, Maipo, Chile	£25.00
Dark with shades of violet. The nose is concentrated and deep, with aromas of cherries, figs, violets and white fruit aromas such as apricots and pears. The palate is long, complex and juicy with soft tannins.	
CUVÉE MATHIEROU 2014 Château La Clotte Fontane, Côteaux du Languedoc, France	£25.00
Complex red wine with a deep red colour. Its nose will delight you with liquorice notes, red berries, and black olives hints. The mouth is powerful, and offers a great concentration with elegant tannins.	
ZUCCARDI SERIE A BONARDA 2015 Familia Zuccardi, Santa Rosa, Mendoza, Argentina	£25.00
Packed with savoury cherry and chocolate character. These rich red and black fruits are supported by silky tannins and kind of acidity that will keep it fresh for a few years to come.	
COLLEFRISIO MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO 2014 Filaré, DOC, Abruzzo, Italy	£25.00
Ruby red colour. A strong fruity scent, containing hints of spices, cherry plum and jam. Well balanced and lasting taste. This is a rich, deeply savoury, complex version of that old Italian classic.

A delicate bouquet of red fruits and subtle spice whilst red pepper and soft tannins fill the palate with hints of liquorice.

Elegant, fresh cherry and red berry nose with undergrowth melange. The palate is pure with lovely texture and sweet cherry fruit dominates with spicy undertones. The wine is fresh and intense with real vibrancy.	
MALBEC 2014 Viña Cobos, Luján de Cuyo & Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina	£28.00
Deep, opaque royal purple, leaning to indigo hues. Very expressive on the nose, displaying gorgeous notes of violet flowers and shortbread. Carries vibrant flavours of blueberry, boysenberry, jam and a precise note of black cherry pie, with chewy, ripe tannins. The fresh finish introduces pleasant spice tones that harmonize with the fruit.

Great depth of ripe plum and blackberry fruit flavours. A full bodied wine with a succulent palate, lively spices and fine velvety tannins.

CROZES-HERMITAGE ROUGE 'LES PIERRELLES' 2013 Domaine Albert Belle, Rhône, France	£29.00
A rich, savoury example from one of the leading lights of the region. Well balanced with dark fruits and subtle spice combined with well integrated wood.	
CHÂTEAU LAMOTHE-CISSAC 2009 Cru Bourgeois, Bordeaux, France	£30.00
A traditional style of Bordeaux that has elegance and savoury fruit in abundance. Well balanced palate with soft tannins and a very delicate finish. Excellent age worthiness. Undergrowth and smoky notes.	
CABERNET FRANC 2013 Raats Family Wines, Stellenbosch, South Africa	£31.00
Sexy, luscious and definition of elegance. Harmoniously integrated flavours of blackberry, black cherry and plum mingle with tobacco, cinnamon and spice. Tannins are soft and gentle on the palate, and hints of dark chocolate and minerality on the long finish. A wine gently crafted with great love, and to be enjoyed the same way.	
IONA PINOT NOIR 2013 Elgin, South Africa	£31.00
Succulent black cherry aroma, bright but delicate and hints of forest floor, with underlying floral and spicy notes. On the palate, the wine is powerful, with silk-textured length.	
RESERVA 2008 Selección de la Familia, Bodegas Luis Cañas, DOCa Rioja, Spain	£32.00
A beautiful ruby colour. A clean nose with good intensity. Complex aromas of leather, ripe sweet fruit and herbs over a base of fine oak. Palate: potent and juicy with structure and good tenacity. The finish shows lots of spice and is ample, complex, long and persistent.	
JOAN GINÉ 2011 Buil y Giné, DOCa Priorat, Catalunya, Spain	£33.00
Mineral entrance on the nose but then very intense fruit flavours appear. Explosion of red fruits on the palate, balanced perfectly with the wood's flavour. The wine is also fresh, structured and very long.	
ZINFANDEL STEINBECK 2013 Eberle Winery, California, Wine-Bush & Cocavin Vineyards, USA	£41.00

Violet colour with deep blue hues. Black and red fruit aromas such as blackberry, plum, strawberry and cherry with delicate notes of herbs, ginger and black pepper. Silky entry with gentle and juicy tannins, perceiving an aromatic complexity. It presents a long and deep finish.
