Iona Wines, South Africa

Iona's vineyards are located in the Highlands, a unique sub-region of Elgin. How appropriate for Scotland! The climate and soil provide an utterly stunning Sauvignon Blanc. Andrew Gunn began his wine life in early 1997 and has enjoyed one success after another.

Nyetimber Estate, England

With the same chalk soil as the northern French region and a similar climate, the classic Champagne varieties thrived in their West Sussex vineyard sites. This is the only producer to make superb quality sparkling wine from estate grown fruit. For them it is all about quality, quality and then again quality.

Cava Brut Reserva, Bodegas Sumarroca

£24.00 plus vat

Combining the fruitiness of Chardonnay with the finesse provided by a touch of Parellada. The purity is guaranteed, with no dosage and long ageing over 36 months.

Cava Brut Rosé, Bodegas Sumarroca

£27.00 plus vat

A bright pink colour with slight beading of persistent bubbles. A very intense cava with elegant notes of red fruit and strawberries combined with floral hints. Fruity and unctuous in the mouth, with a delicate finish.

Cava Brut Nature Gran Reserva, Bodegas Sumarroca

Pale yellow colour. Fresh, complex aroma that mixes pastry notes from the cava's 36-month aging with light hints of fresh fruit from the base wine. Savennières, Clos St Yves, Domaine des Baumard, Loire, France, 2015 £45.00 plus vat Intense aromas of green apple, honey, apricot and white flowers with a hint of gun smoke. The fruit of Chenin is clean and bright on the palate with a perfect minerality. Torrontés, Salta, Serie A, Zuccardi, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016 Citrusy and tropical fruit on the nose, with abundant floral notes. Dry and medium bodied on the palate with quite refreshing acidity. Well balanced fruit with spiciness and lavender. £28.00 plus vat

Well-structured and balanced, wonderfully elegant blend of apricot and peaches with a warming hint of ginger spice. Just off dry in style with a great structure and minerality.

New Zealand

Gewürztraminer, Zephyr Wines, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2016

Bright straw green in colour. Enticing red capsicum, gooseberry and freshly cut lemongrass on the nose. Focused primary fruit with elegant textural weight and balanced lingering acidity.

Riesling, Mount Edward, Central Otago, New Zealand, 2017

Vibrant nose of apple blossom and orange zest with just a hint of ginger leading to a bracingly fresh palate of apple and lime. With surprising weight and texture, this clean and linear Riesling is a delightful shock to the palate with real purity and eternal finish.

Tempranillo Rosado, Castillo del Moro, Vinos Más Buscados, La Mancha, Spain, 2016

This Rosado is crammed full of juicy wild strawberry, raspberry and cranberry fruit.

Rich in colour, the wine is crisp and well balanced with a long finish of strawberries and cream.

France

Rosé, IGP Pays d'Hérault, Pierre et Papa, Languedoc, France, 2016

Bright pink, this is a light and refreshing rosé bursting with red fruits, lychee and green apple, a perfect balance of roundness and length which makes for an easy drinking wine for all seasons.

Tradition, Domaine Sainte Marie, Côtes de Provence, France, 2016

This pink and exquisite wine starts with various fragrances of peach, grape, apricot, boxwood and a bud of blackcurrant. A mix of sensations which declines with even stronger sensations in the mouth.

Italy

Aromatic and intense with lovely aromas of wild red berries, blossom, nutmeg and hints of sandalwood. Fresh, fruity and well balanced with sensations of raspberries, vanilla and cinnamon. Textural, well balanced and a great expression of Rioja.

Reserva Selección de la Familia, Bodegas Luis Cañas, Rioja, Spain, 2011

A beautiful ruby colour. A clean nose with good intensity. Complex aromas of leather, ripe sweet fruit and herbs over a base of fine oak. The finish shows lots of spice and is ample, complex, long and persistent.

Cair Crianza, Dominio de Cair, Castillo y Léon, Spain, 2012

Black cherry with good depth of colour. An intense nose of fine wood, leather, cigars, dark chocolate and fruit combine with sweet tannins to produce a beautifully balanced, elegant red wine. Full and powerful on the attack with good balance. A meaty and juicy mouth feel, with sweet tannins. Long, lingering finish.

Joan Giné Rouge, Buil y Giné, Catalunya, Spain, 2012

£47.00 plus vat

Mineral entrance on the nose but then very intense fruit flavours appear. Explosion of red fruits on the palate, balanced perfectly with the wood's flavour. The wine is also fresh, structured and very long.

Romania

Syrah, Umbrele, Ville Timisului, Romania, 2016

£21.00 plus vat

Cherry red colour with a fruit filled nose and smoky nuances. Integrated toasty oak with Syrah flavours.

Chile

Malbec, Bío Bío, Nostros Reserva, Indómita, Bío Bío Valley, Chile, 2016

£23.00 plus vat

Deep and intense ruby colour, mature and aromatic. A fine and elegant wine with well-balanced levels of alcohol and acidity. Flavours of black cherry, strawberry, and raspberry. On the nose powerful, sweet notes. A lingering finish, flavourful with velvety, soft and ripe tannins.

Merlot, Los Espinos, Espinos Y Cardos, Central Valley, Chile, 2017

£23.00 plus vat

This easy-drinking wine comes from Chile's renowned Valle Central Region, where long hot days are followed by cool nights. This temperature difference ensures the grapes ripen slowly, so they develop maximum flavour. This is simply outstanding wine for the money, soft superjuicy ripe plummy fruit and a long full-flavoured finish.



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France

Cabernet Sauvignon, IGP Pays d'Oc, Casse Noix, Languedoc, France, 2015

Garnet red in colour, perfumed with fragrant black cherry, cassis, black pepper and cinnamon. Full bodied and intense with countless layers of flavour including blackcurrant, cedar and graphite. Dense fruit on the palate is bound by a structure of fine grained tannins and a lively acidity. This wine shows great depth and character and yet is refined with a long, elegant finish.

Pinot Noir, IGP Pays d'Oc, Montsablé, Languedoc, France, 2016

£26.00 plus vat

This classic Burgundian variety has been produced in the sunny climate of Languedoc. Red ruby colour. Aromatic nose of black cherries with elegant floral notes. On the palate, this Pinot Noir is silky and well balanced, with smooth tannins.

Cuvée Mathierou, AOP, Château La Clotte Fontane, Languedoc, France, 2015

£29.00 plus vat

Complex red wine with a deep red colour. Its nose will delight you with liquorice notes, red berries, and black olives hints. The mouth is powerful, and offers a great concentration with elegant tannins.

Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Guillaume Gonnet, Rhône, France, 2015

This wine is fleshy, ripe and finishes with impressive forest floor sweetness, rounded out by peppery tannins.

Crozes-Hermitage, Les Pierrelles, Domaine Albert Belle, Rhône, France, 2015

A rich, savoury example from one of the leading lights of the region. Well balanced with dark fruits and subtle spice combined with well integrated wood.

Château Lamothe-Cissac, Bordeaux, France, 2014

A traditional style of Bordeaux that has elegance and savoury fruit in abundance. Well balanced palate with soft tannins and a very delicate finish. Excellent age worthiness. Undergrowth and smoky notes.

Rully 1er Cru Rouge, Clos du Chapitre, Domaine Jaeger-Defaix, Burgundy, France, 2014

Fine, elegant and very classic Burgundian style of Pinot noir. Aromas of red and black fruit dominate the nose with violets and cherry in abundance. Fine, supple tannins and a refreshing acidity on the palate make this a truly remarkable bottle of Pinot.

Gevrey-Chambertin, Symphonie, Domaine Burguet, Burgundy, France, 2012

£105.00 plus vat

Wow! Aromas of pure raspberries and damsons with spice. Concentrated palate with ripe, sweet fruit flavours, chocolate and spice. The tannins are smooth and silky giving texture and structure to this skilfully crafted wine.

Château Clos Vieux Taillefer, Bordeaux, France, 2011

£120.00 plus vat

This exquisite Pomerol was rightly voted "Best Merlot in the World" at the International Wine and Spirit competition in 2009 and the 2010 seems to be equally as good. Beneath its deep, ruby-red robe there is a supple and full-bodied wine with notes of caramelised cherry mixed with mild spices and cinnamon. Notes of vanilla and cigar box, with a wonderful length.

Lebanon

Source de Rouge Cabernet Merlot Syrah, Château Ka, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon, 2014

£32.00 plus vat

A delicate bouquet of red fruits and subtle spice whilst red pepper and soft tannins fill the palate with hints of liquorice.



Italy

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Filaré, DOC, Collefrisio, 2015

Ruby red colour. A strong fruity scent, containing hints of spices, cherry plum and jam. Well balanced and lasting taste. This is a rich, deeply savoury, complex version of that old Italian classic.

Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore, Campo dei Ciliegi, DOC, ILatium Morini, Veneto, Italy, 2014 Intense garnet in colour with ripe cherries, herby and earthy aromas. A warm and dry sour cherry palate in the fore, with loads of intensity of raisins and sultanas and a rich fresh soft tannic finish.

Barolo, 4 Vigne, DOCG, Cascina Adelaide, Piedmont, Italy, 2013

Brilliant garnet colour, plum, wild blueberry, cinnamon and liquorice delight the nose. Gentle on the palate with elegantly fused tannins.

South Africa

Mr P Pinot Noir, Iona, Elgin, South Africa, 2016

Elegant, fresh cherry and red berry nose with undergrowth melange. The palate is pure with lovely texture and sweet cherry fruit dominates with spicy undertones. The wine is fresh and intense with real vibrancy.

Pinot Noir, Iona, Elgin, South Africa, 2014

Succulent black cherry aroma, bright but delicate and hints of forest floor, with underlying floral and spicy notes. On the palate, the wine is powerful, with silk-textured length.

Cabernet Franc, Raats Family Wines, Stellenbosch, South Africa, 2015

Sexy, luscious and definition of elegance. Harmoniously integrated flavours of blackberry, black cherry and plum mingle with tobacco, cinnamon and spice. Tannins are soft and gentle on the palate, and hints of dark chocolate and minerality on the long finish. A wine gently crafted with great love, and to be enjoyed the same way.

Argentina

Bonarda, Santa Rosa, Serie A, Zuccardi, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016

Packed with savoury cherry and chocolate character. These rich red and black fruits are supported by silky tannins and kind of acidity that will keep it fresh for a few years to come.

Malbec, Felino, Viña Cobos, Mendoza, Argentina, 2016

Deep, opaque royal purple, leaning to indigo hues. Very expressive on the nose, displaying gorgeous notes of violet flowers and shortbread. Carries vibrant flavours of blueberry, boysenberry, jam and a precise note of black cherry pie, with chewy, ripe tannins. The fresh finish introduces pleasant spice tones that harmonize with the fruit.

Tito Zuccardi, Paraje Altamira, Valle de Uco, Icon, Zuccardi, Mendoza, Argentina, 2014 Violet colour with deep blue hues. Black and red fruit aromas such as blackberry, plum,

strawberry and cherry with delicate notes of herbs, ginger and black pepper. Silky entry with gentle and juicy tannins, perceiving an aromatic complexity. It presents a long and deep finish. £28.00 plus vat
